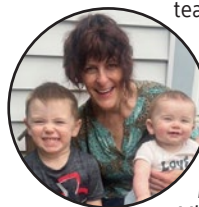
## Dolly Parton Imagination Library

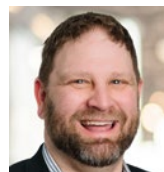

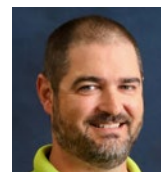

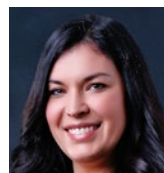

At Mitchell Area United Way, we believe in the power of community—coming together to support local programs that change lives every day.

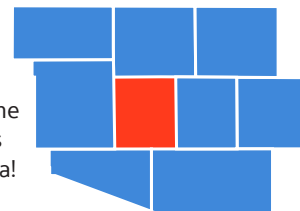
